

TRAINING OF TRAINERS (TOT) ON PSYCHOSOCIAL CARE IN DISASTERS



A three day Training of Trainers (TOT) programme on Psychosocial Care in Disasters was organized by the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), East Khasi Hills, Shillong in St. Anthony's College, Shillong from 20th to 22nd March 2018. This workshop was conducted by the National Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences, (Institute of National Importance), Bengaluru under the aegis of the USAID-MHA-UNDP partnership project titled, "Developing Resilient Cities through Risk Reduction in the context of Disasters and Climate Change" which is being implemented in Shillong. A total of 33 (thirty three) participants from various government and non-government agencies were trained to become Master Trainers in the field of psychosocial care who in turn would capacitate their respective departmental staff on the topic. Such trained people would be able to render their services in the area of psycho-social care in the event of a disaster in the city and neighbouring areas.
